	Socks Wool (1 or 2 pairs) (winter)		
	Thermal underwear (winter) synthetic non-absorbent is best Pack all clothes in large plastic zip lock bags to keep dry.	1 or 2	
	Winter coat, hat and gloves (seasonal)	1	
	Boots, hiking - waterproof	1pr	
	Camp shoes - light and small (old sneakers or topsiders) for around camp.	1pr	
Personal Care	Tooth Brush	1	
	Soap, Shampoo, deodorant etc.,	1	
	Towel (in plastic bag)	1	
	Comb/brush	1

	12' Rope (clothesline and back pack tie-up)	1	
Carrying Equipment	Backpack - full size for backwoods camping (use rope only to attach sleeping bag or tent - no bungies)(cover sleeping gear for rain)	1 or	
	Day pack and a Duffel bag for trips where lodging is close to vehicles	1
